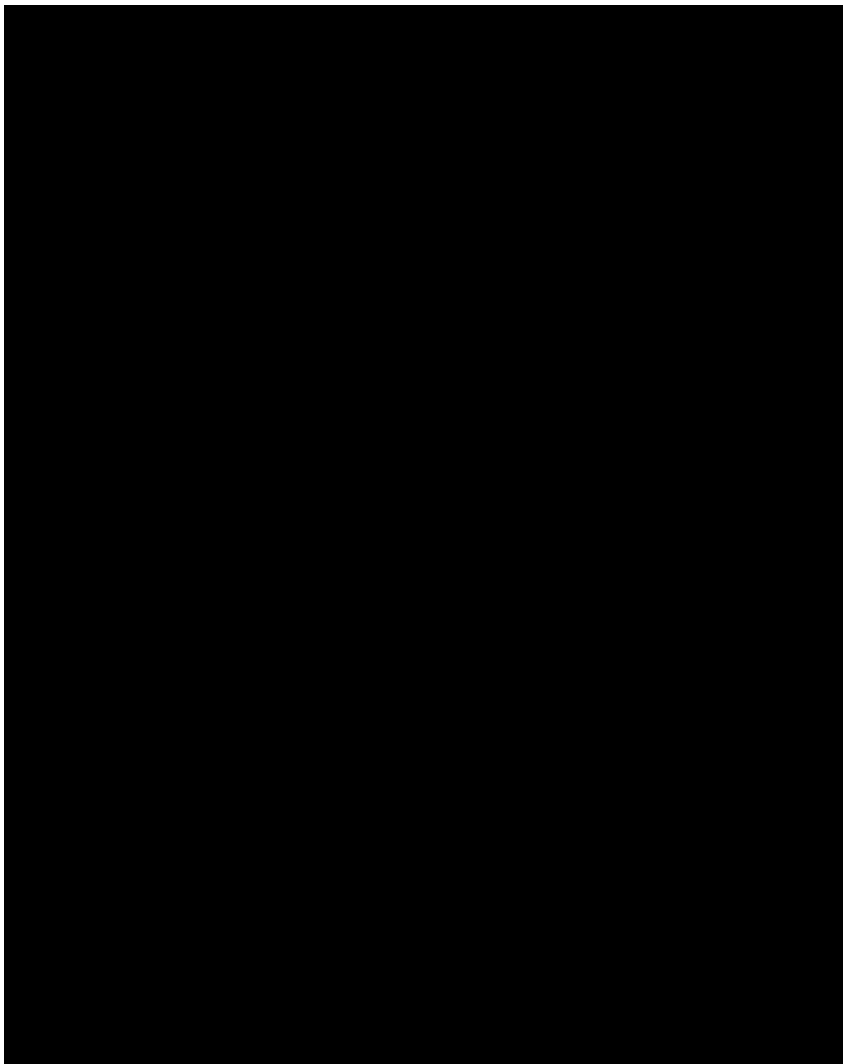

## How do I prepare for my interview?
